The Cheshire Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) and the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) will consider the results of this consultation and the comments left by residents before publishing a full Police and Crime Plan later in 2025.

About the survey

The survey was launched on Monday 3rd December 2024 and ran until 12noon on Friday 20th December 2024.

Overall, there were 1,141 responses to the survey.

Cheshire population

Cheshire has an approximate population of 1,112,105. Approximate populations¹ by local authority area are:

- Cheshire East – 406,500
- Cheshire West and Chester – 365,061
- Warrington – 211,580
- Halton – 128,964

The number of survey responses received during this consultation gives the OPCC a confidence level of 99% with a 4% margin of error.

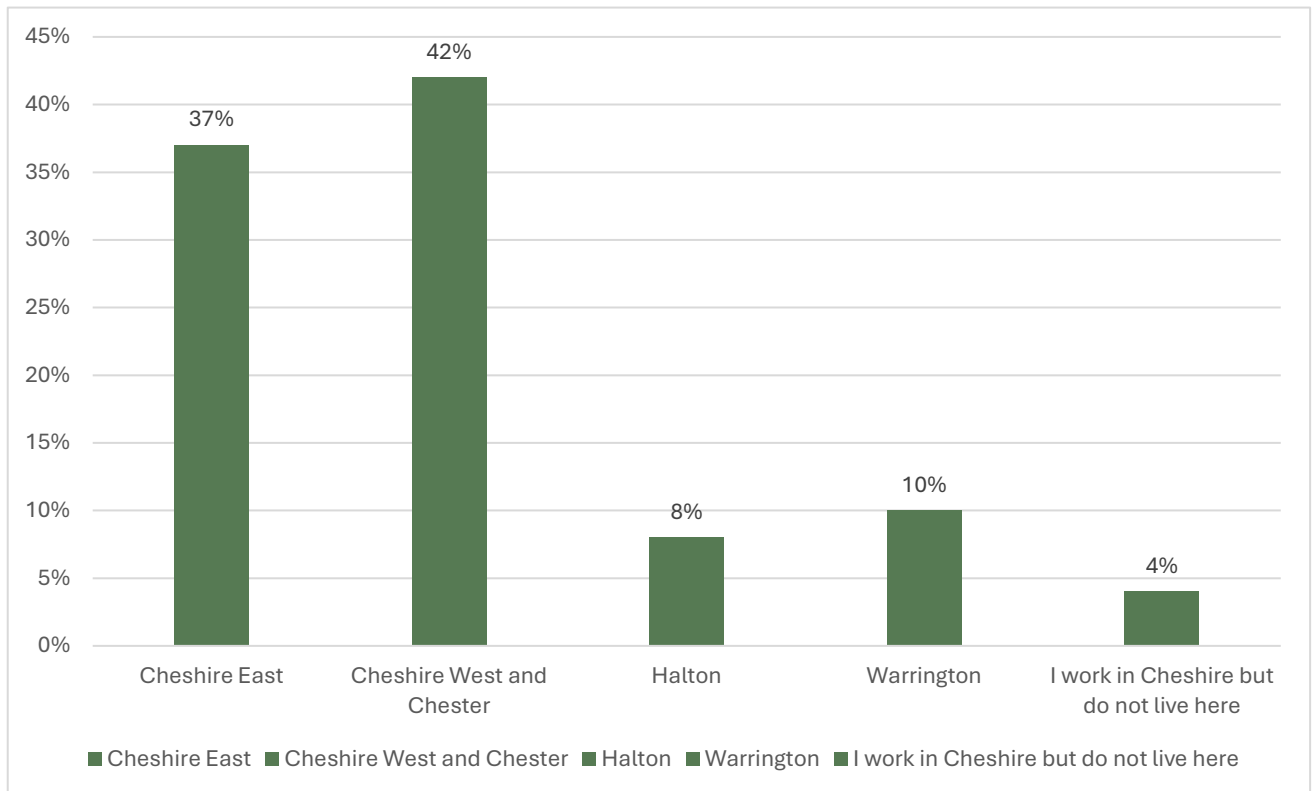


Survey question analysis

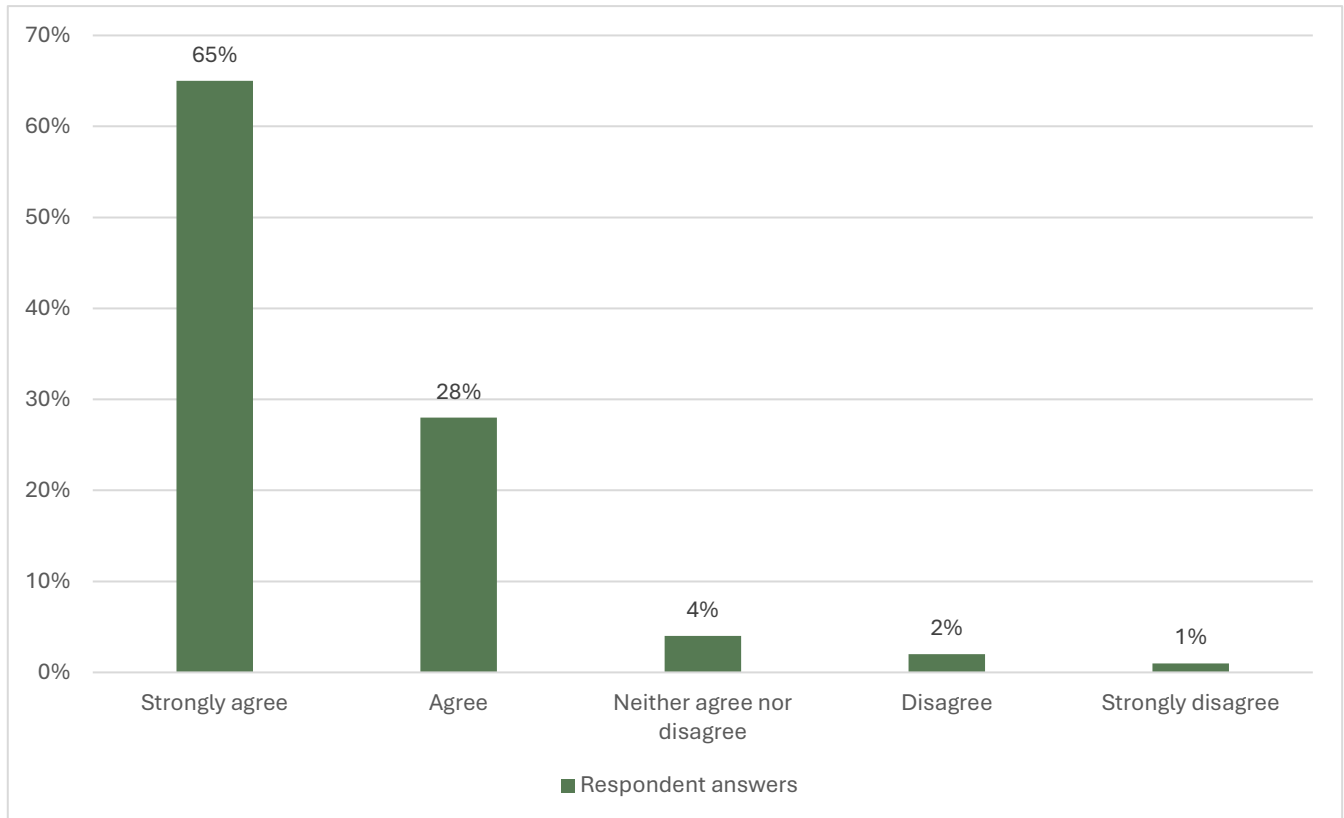




Q2. "Public trust and confidence is key to effective policing". How much do you agree with this statement?

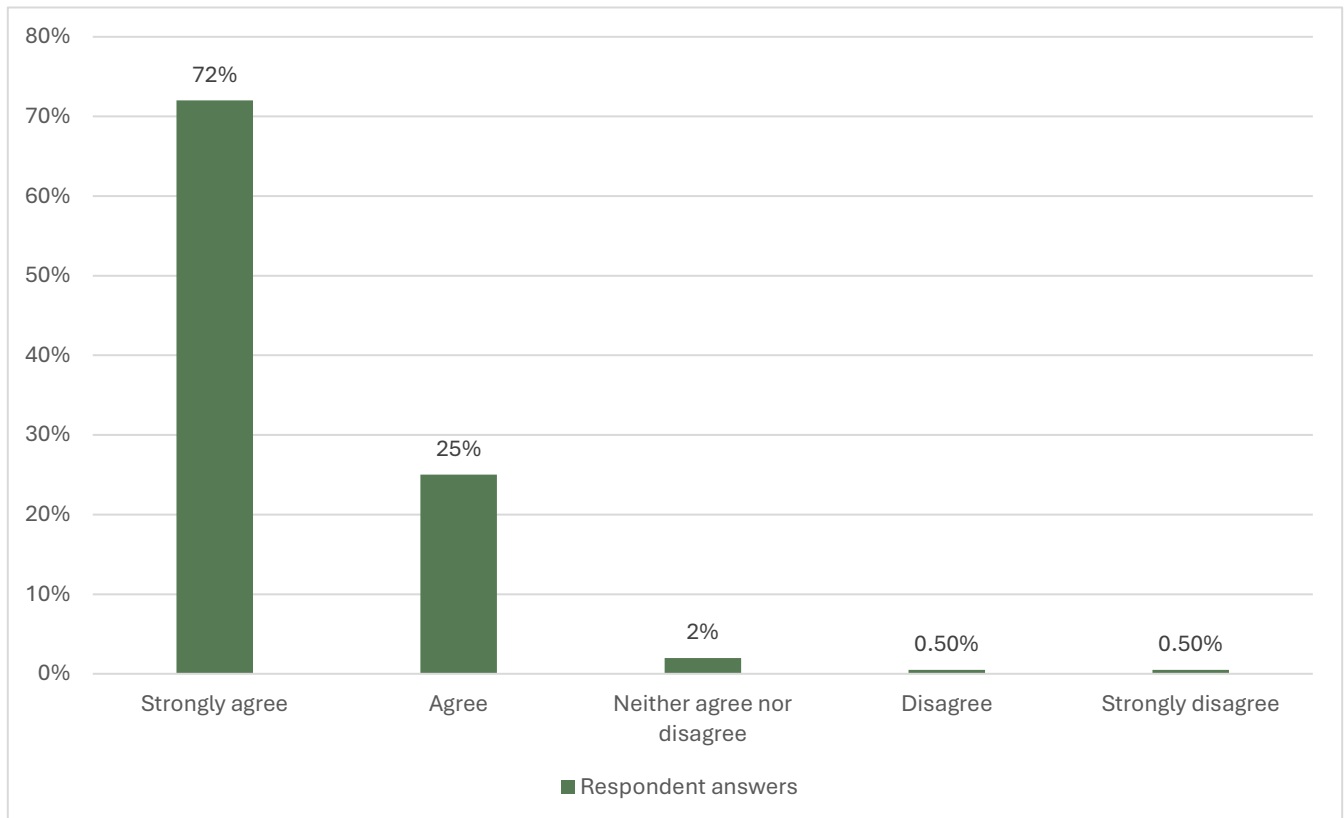




Q3. "Do you believe that reducing crime is essential to create thriving communities". How much do you agree with this statement?

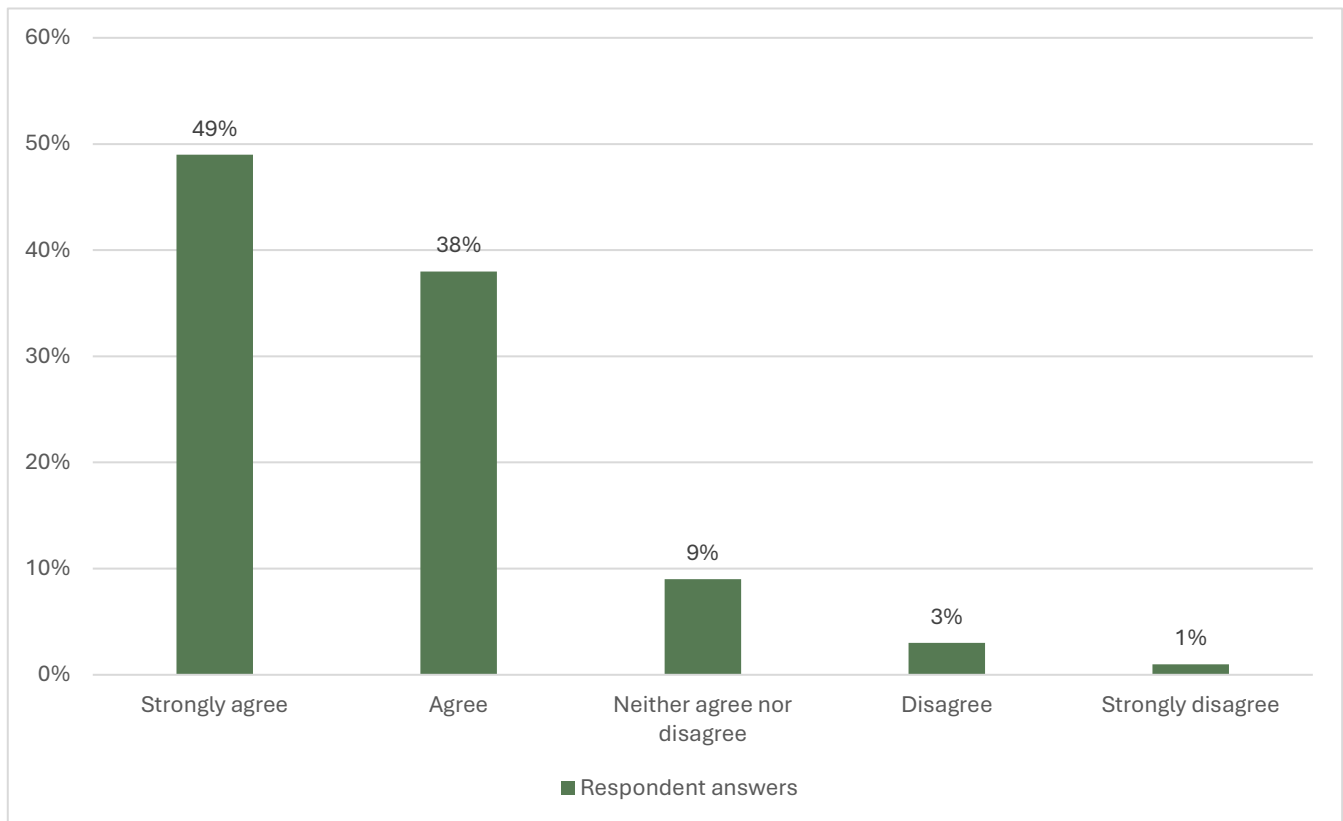




**Q4. "Local people should have a say in how their communities are policed".

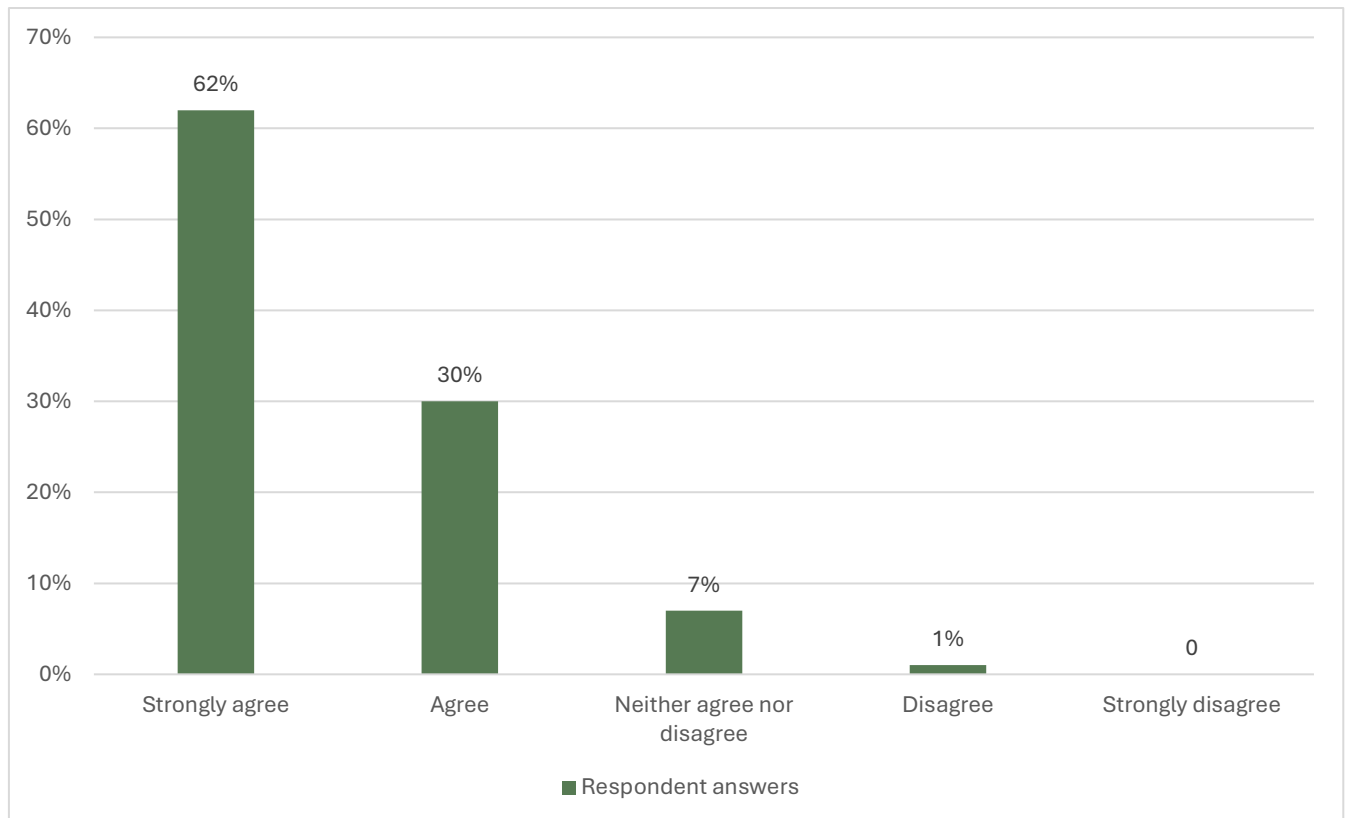
